BS, your CPU and GPU function better if they are cooler, the colder the better. Besides, if you let your components run too hot, they'll wear off faster.

His CPU would also "function better" at 3.5 GHz compared to 3 GHz. Depending on the kind of cooling one has, the P4 Cs can reach some pretty high speeds. If his case has no fans or something, then maybe heat could be a problem. Overclocking can reduce the lifespan of your CPU or GPU.
