There is also a program called Swish that I've used. It's much more user friendly and much much cheaper. There are some higher end features Flash has that Swish does not , but for a beginner, Swish is the way to go. I work with a lot of Flash and I do have to warn you. After importing 200 High quality Images, the .swf file might be big. They get compressed to about 20% of there original size.
