As for the issue of haveing to have the core patch to work then you could simply set up a few servers that require it to play similar to some that require renguard now,but the core patch additions could be disabled if a supporting server isn't recognized when you connect in a similar way that you get a message saying this isn't a renguard protected server but only for the patch instead of renguard.
