Nitrogen fixation is used to make inorganic atmospheric Nitrogen into organic Nitrogen making Ammonia (NH<sub>3</sub>), this is nitrified to Nitrites (NO<sub>2</sub>), which can be used as fertilisers but is usually further nitrified to Nitrates (NO<sub>3</sub>) which can be absorbed easier by plants so makes better fertilisers.
