When the pc is booting up press the F8 key (I press repeatedly til the menu comes up), then use the down key to select Safe Mode, then choose the Windows partion. Should only be one unless you run another OS or 2 the same.

When it has booted up, on XP you can choose the Administrator, or other version you have to type the name in. This is normally not password protected but if it is you may need to search google for a tool.
