OK,

First of all, I want to applaud the efforts made by BHS and its members eg Crimson.

Now that's out of the way,

The fault is with Renguard itself, BHS has not kept up to date with the OS of current time and just been happy that it works for Win98 etc.

Of course, to the common user, Win98 went out of use by the end of 2000 or at the latest 2001. This is what I mean, out of date....

Windows 2000 and Windows XP, even 64 bit OS are having probs with Renguard as they don't support what Renguard is trying to do. This causes a number of different effects depending on your OS.

My OS for the past 4 years has been Win2000 Pro. I got back into playing Renegade about 1 yr ago only to find this damn thing was nagging the crap out of me about getting Renguard, sometimes getting kicked cause I didn't have it.

Hosts on some servers use this to get rid of people to make a game unfair or because they just don't like you, this abuse, unfortunately can't be administrated and thus it's going on without any checks.

BHS, should for all intensive purposes, forget the little issues like small exploits, at this stage who cares. Users are getting kicked, abused, called cheaters etc because BHS to this has failed to release a stable program for the above mentioned OS systems.

As a last note,

The community is suffering, users are leaving or giving up on waiting. The so called Anti cheat program has made the community dependant on a program then hasn't kept up to date and thus everyone suffers.

I only ask that BHS release a working program soon before the community comes to a steady but progressing DEATH.

Again I have no bias in this matter, I am just an end user, I applaud the efforts made so far, just dissatisfied like many other end users cause my experience with online Renegade has been very poor due to the inefficiency of Renguard and the community dependency on a flawed ( at this stage ) Anti-cheat program.
