PackHunter wrote on Sun, 16 July 2006 20:38 Monitors DO NOT influence FPS in ANY way. You might see some ghosting (blurring) on LCD screens with response times of over 10 milliseconds, but that won't show in a screenshot anyway.

If your FPS drops when games get larger, it's probably your CPU, memory or bus speed that's the bottleneck, but not your videocard and definitely not your monitor. Isn't it strange that the exact same computer gets a 60 FPS with CRT and gets FPS problems with a flat screen on it, about 20 seconds later?
