Whitedragon wrote on Mon, 11 September 2006 23:36 Establish a TCP connection with the IRC server on port 6667, then send the following commands:

```
"NICK <Nick here>"
```

```
"USER <User here> * 0 :<Name here>"
```

If you receive a RAW 433 command back from the server, that means the nick you selected is in use and you need to choose another one.

When you receive a RAW 376(MOTD) from the server you should start joining channels, identify for your nick, etc.

thanks, it worked (at last ) but i dont get the USER command :/ does it just show who you really are?

also i cannot login with my original nick it says that it is in use.
