I guess it's the TI-84 now, but it's a solid design with enough features that-unless you're doing some seriously heavy-duty advanced mathematics- you shouldn't need anything else.

If you need a scientific calculator to use for tests and don't already have one (most math classes won't allow you to use the graphing calculator, as others here have said), I recommend the TI-30.
