We recently experimented with our language filter.

The results:

1. Kick on bad language causes people to complain the server is too strict, but leads to less heated arguments
2. No language filter causes less complaints but more heated arguments
3. Warn for language (3rd warn = kick) acts as a decent way to stop people swearing without having as many "too strict" complaints

End result we've stuck with warn for language and it seems to work well.
