Dualcore certainly has it advantages. Yes in single threaded applications it might be slower (if the megahertz are lower) but, since we don't work in dos any more and do things like multitasking, you'll benefit from a dualcore even if you're just running single threaded apps.

Everything \*feels\* faster, even in just plain old windows. Also, if one application hangs and uses 100% of 1 core, you can still run taskmanager etc to kill it, on a dual core. Try that on a single core and you'll fail, miserably again.
