My suggestion is using PowerISO to compress to .daa, which is essentially an iso whose files are all "optimized" (compressed). I've seen 650MB files go down to 580MB, in some cases lower.

Of course, you have to pay [] for PowerISO (for anything >300MB), but it's so worth it just for the compression.
