Quote:Offensive names will be subject to an objection-based process based on public morality and order. This process will be conducted by an international arbitration body utilizing criteria drawing on provisions in a number of international treaties. ICANN will not be the decision maker on these objections.

And it will be mostly domain registrars who will be buying the TLD's so they can profit off the FQDN's sold to everyday customers with personal websites. Whether they would want their company name associated with questionable TLD's I wouldn't know, though.
