Reason why im saying this is because the "browser - html display" object exists in vb.net, as well as the creation of menus is quite easy and possible.

If you actually meant to make a "good" browser, don't do it in vb, go for c++ or at least c#. The difference between making this in vb.net and vb is quite little and you'll probably have less difficulty and a more advanced interface in .net. Also the .net has objects for tabbed pages.
