Easiest way to overclock your nvidia card is downlaodign the latest forceware drivers from your favorite source, get coolbits 2.0 tweak & install, open the nvidia control panel, go to overclock setting or something like that, and fiddle with the settings till either the computer needs a reset, or you get artifacts in the screen.

That's how easy it is. Didn't even have to google for it. For Nvidia cards it is the same for every type.

For Ati you'll need to use the "advanced" control panel, enable overdrive, and start fiddling around till either the computer needs a reset, or you get artifacts in the screen.

Here goes the same as for Nvidia, this way works for all Ati cards.
