The dot is what matters. But the outside reticule still exists. Thus, removing it, makes it easier to use.

It's the removal of an optical illusion originating from the outer crosshair. I've tested it in many different aspects and found that the smaller the outer reticule (or closer it is to the center dot) the easier it is to aim.

One may not notice if they aren't necessarily looking for it, but the difference is there. It may also depend on who is using it, because people see and perceive different ways.
