Though if you dont finalize a non-rewritable CD you can add data to it at a later moment

EDIT: not an available option in some burning programs and only adding will work. To replace you really need RW's

I am talking about AUDIO ... not data. I never tried to not finalize a audio cd.

Works exactly the same way. I said data but i just used that to make clear it applies to all 1 and 0 burned to the disc

Unless your CD player is old and doesnt play non-finalized CD's this would apply, though when it is old then it would probably not even be able to play MP3 because of its age
