Yes as long as it is not using certain files: objects.ddb (mix's can only use temps20.ddb) strings.tdb (mix's don't support modified strings) Certain tga and dds files (some pkg's change the loading screens and things like that, and to my knowledge mixes can't take correct advantage of that (not that pkg's actually do it right in the first place, sometimes you have to load them up twice to get it to work). Certain modified ini files.

However, some of these you can make it into a mix without, it'll just use the stock ren stuff in place, but if the objects file has been modified, tough luck.
