I know I do if I run it but I'm running it directly, not installed.

I long lost your TeamViewer info but yes I did once connect to you. IDK if you recall but that was when you were working in C++ with registry keys and needed help with that.

You might want to use LogMeIn instead of TeamViewer for remote access. I personally do and it is more secure as they won't be able to ever login with a simple id/pass combination (which are both numbers only). They'd need access to your LogMeIn account and know your windows username/password combination.

You can still use TeamViewer if you need some help but atleast then you can monitor who connects as you're right there on the computer.
