Congrats on useless logs. Those ips trace back to no one from our community nor any of our servers. You might as well print those out glue them to construction paper and bring them to your local police department and see what they have to say about it.

I'm not sure if you know how to read or not. It was a server from Staminus, a host provider which granted Animoski a dedicated server for a free month, which he didn't get around to using for anything other than that attack. Why did he accept it if he wasn't going to use it for anything? The original intent was at least legal:

Though as far as the "bring them to your local police department" goes, there are two problems:
1) Too late; 2) I chose not to, despite the fact that Staminus recommended that I do so ("We strongly request that you file a police report"), because as it turns out, I'm not a fan of legal action.
