v.99 runs without the disk, but also isn't equipped to recieve update patches. v.991 requires the CD and is also ready for updates.

A little of those notes:

Dante #1: The initial installer was fucked, i admit it, and i have fixed it, as well as "discluding" some files that should not have been sent with the initial release. Soooo, to make a long story short, you will have to download the entire thing again. Good news being, it will fix everything that was wrong and make it a stable basis for future updates, bad news is, well... thats a big file to download. For those of you that ordered CD's, the correct version (as stated above) will be on the CD, not the messed up initial one. I tried to make it patchable, but it was just to big, and you might as well start it correctly (was something like 179 megs).
