DDR 2 is different because 1, it either has more transistors, and/or 2, faster switching ones, and/or 3 sending more bits each time for example upgrading processors from 32bit to 64bit. There will be clear design differences for the DDR chips themselves, but it is still going to be the same DDR-2 chips being used as GDDR-2 or system ram DDR-2.
