It was bought to my attention that setting game.exe into [b]COMPATIBLITY MODE?[/b?] to Windows 98/ME fixes this problem temporarly. It isn't prefect, but it least it starts.

Also, the "quit" button seems to crash then when being in compatbility mode.

Set your shortcut to compatbility mode (Windows 98) when having game.exe crash issues.
