Increasing the refresh rate is almost irrelevant too, because the lowest the refresh rate can get is some 56. 2 men with equal skill would do equally well with 56 and 100 FPS.

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For me, I begin to not tell the difference above 70 fps. I've played Renegade at 250 fps before (lowered the resolution to 640x400 to test my top speed) and the speed felt the same as 70 fps.

Trust me, you CAN tell the difference above 40 fps. 70 fps feels like turbo mode, 60 fps feels slightly less.
