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You can uninstall RenGuard from the "Add/Remove Programs" in your control panel. Although, you do not need to uninstall RenGuard to play Renegade w/o RenGuard. All you need to do, without the hastle of uninstalling something just to possibly get it again, is to point your Renegade Shortcuts to "game2.exe" instead of "game.exe"... this will Load Renegade w/o RenGuard for the time being.

Either way, you won't be RenGuard protected.

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A problem in the add/remove programs is that it reports the size of Renguard to be the same as Renegade's, leading people to believe that uninstalling RG removes Renegade too.

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what you can do is, rename the current game.exe (RG) to Renguard.exe and then rename game2.exe back to the default game.exe.

Then when you double click the Renegade icons from the desktop and/or start menu, it will launch Renegade instantly.

You will still have Renguard on your system, but it won't be launched when you load up renegade. To get RG back again, just do the reverse from the above steps.
