I connect and the list is "requesting" indefinitely and gives me a list of mostly empty servers. I can interupt "requesting" by trying to join a server.

Upon clicking on a server i either will get the joining message which leads to unable to join or the "start" screen which wont show players names and is faded out. The refresh button becomes faded out after this and inaccesable.
