- 1) The server is full-RenGuard, meaning that *every* user must use it (which usually is NOT the case)
- 2) The user has previously been voted off by the very same method you've mentioned: three RenGuard users requested that the user being kicked be required to use RenGuard.

As hinted at above, most half-RenGuard servers (eg, servers that don't *require* players to use RenGuard) have a command that allows other players to vote to require a player to be forced to run RunGuard, usually !forcerg < playername >.
