/msg NickServ register KluYa Cecil.Harvey@FF4LunaBase.net /NickServ register MistDragon Rydia_of_Mist@Village.of.Mist.com /NS register Mindslave KainHighwind@GolbezsOutpost.org

To later Identify yourself with the server(to again get "+r"), do this:

Function:

/msg NickServ identify <password> /NickServ identify <password> /NS identify <password>

Examples:

/msg NickServ identify KluYa /NickServ identify MistDragon /NS identify Mindslave

For further help, it's highly suggested you take a moment to personally query NickServ. To do so, simply type one of the following:

Function: /msg NickServ help /NickServ help /NS help

Remember. The nickname your register is the only nickname you can Identify yourself for unless you link nicknames.(If the server allows it.) Another benefit of registering your nickname is that no one else may use that name without the password. Therefore, don't give out your password.
