My ping is not the constant 70 that it usually is, but 350+, I lag horribly, having a 2 second or so delay, and on top of that, I'm not sure what the problem is as I get kicked off by Renguard saying that I'm using a LAN exploit.

So now, your all probably saying that it's my wireless routers fault (and this is what I think it is too). However, I was just wondering if the new Renguard update or perhaps CP2 have caused others connection problems, as it can just as equally be any one of those two too...

Anyways, I personally believe it's the routers fault and so I'll try and get it out of here, although I doubt that I'll be able to...

I'd like to hear some opinions as to what the problem might be, if anyone has any...
