Run it from cmd.exe and the text will stay on the screen so you can read it.

EG, if your bot is called bot.exe, in the folder C:\mybot

```
run cmd.exe
type
cd c:\mybot <press enter>
bot.exe <press enter>
```

Your bot will run, and when it crashes it will stay on screen

EXAMPLE;

I cut most of the window off, but you get the idea.
