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He means banned from XWIS. Not Renguard or a game server. You can get banned from XWIS in many ways. I know you can get banned from chat for bad language in lobbies of games such as Red Alert 2, Yuri's and Tiberian Sun so it's probably the same in the Renegade lobbies. Persistant

offenders can get banned. There are other ways to get a serial banned, like connecting to XWIS with a spam script to spam page them. I doubt your friend would do any of these things though.

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
