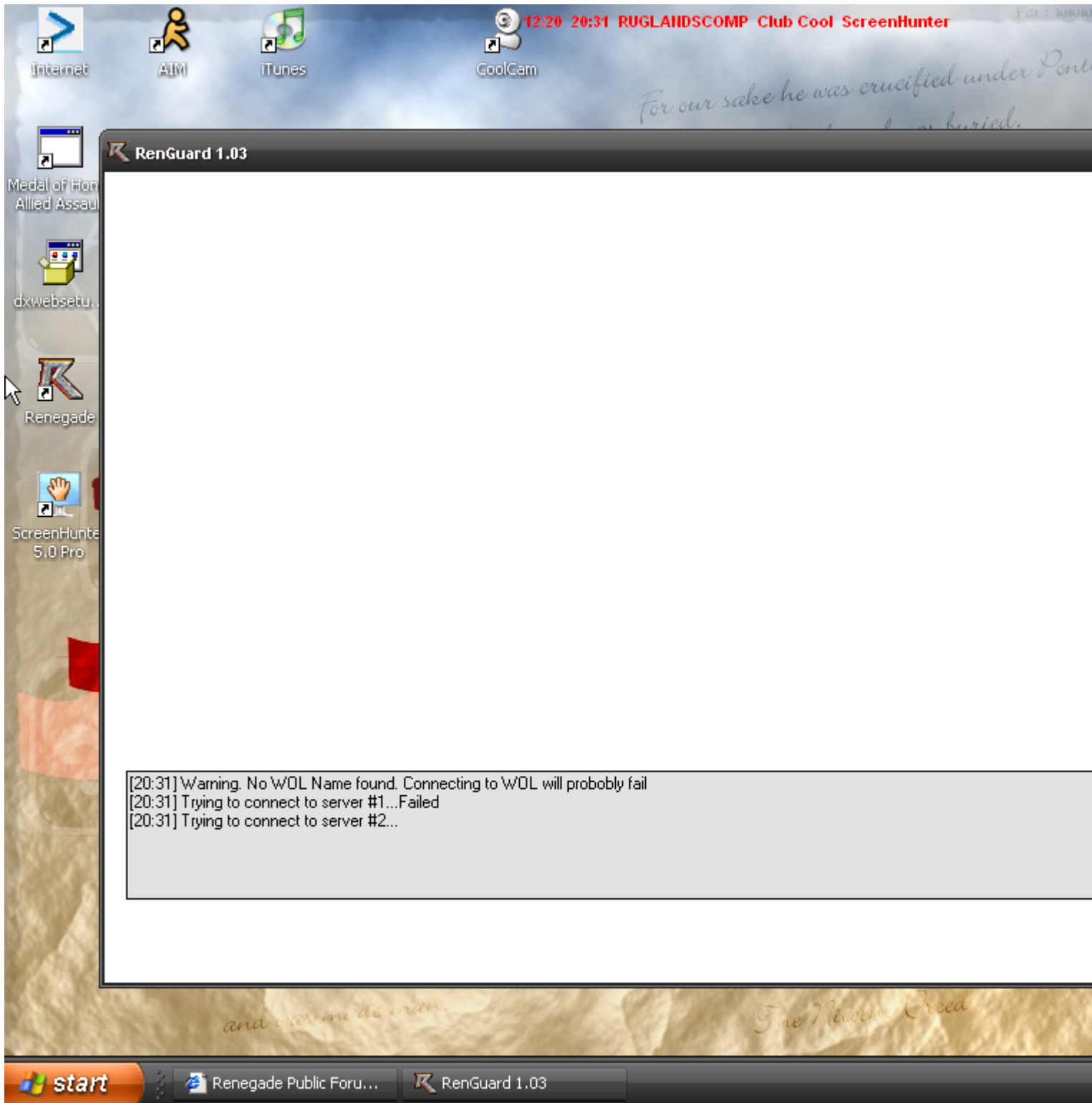
UPDATE: I downloaded renguard, and I tried to run it and it said, "No WOL Name found.
