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For those of you who use Windows Live! Messenger, I have created a simple little plugin that Auto-Reponds a message that you set.

Instructions:

1. Download the attached DCOMAutoReply.AddIn.dll and put it in the MSN Messenger directory. (C:\Program Files\MSN Messenger\).

2. Enable AddIns for Live Messenger: Run 'regedit' and go to the key 'HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Microsoft\MSNMessenger\' and edit the key 'AddInFeatureEnabled' to a value of 1. If the key does not exist then create it. (Its a DWORD type).

3. Restart Live Messenger. Now go to Tools->Options->AddIns and click the button 'Add to Messenger' and browse for DCOMAutoReply.AddIn.dll that you placed in the MSN Messenger directory.

To actually turn the AddIn on, you must click the drop down arrow next to your name and click 'Turn on DCOMAutoResponder'. You can now use the settings button in the AddIn options tab to change the message displayed when you have the AddIn turned on.

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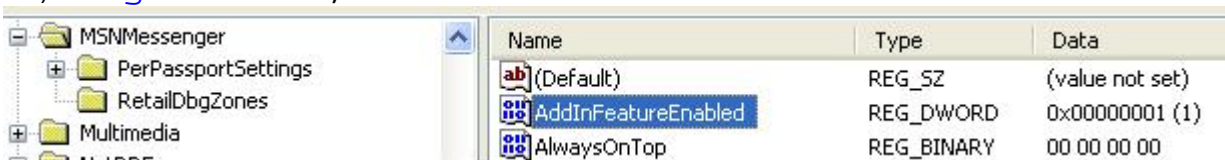

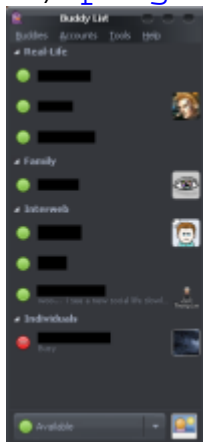
