Operation timed out.

Firewall port negotiation timed out.

We've tried everything we know of related to ports and firewalls, but nothing's working apparently. However, we are both able to join other servers without any problem.

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For the moment make sure your friends windows hasn't added game2.exe to the blocked list of Windows Firewall.

I know you've mentioned about ports and whatnot. But is this server dedicated? if so ask him to try changing the ports to something uncommon.

Let me know how this works.

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It's a router port forward problem of the person hosting the server. You're probably not hosting a dedicated server, hence you cannot set the port to use. Look in the stickies in win32fds or renegade client, I think there's one with the standard ports.

If you don't mind about opening all your ports, then you can always put your router in DMZ (demilitarized zone) but this implies some security holes.
