XCC Mixer (XCC tools) freezes whenever it tries to load skirmish00.mix for Renegade, I'm not sure why. This computer was purchased brand new not long ago and I found it does this on the old comp as well.
Renegade Extractor (from renhelp.net) won't open MIX files from other games such as Tiberian Sun and Red Alert 2. Whenever I try to do this I get an error "Mix is a bad format or is corrupted" or something.
Unmix (another program I found on google) doesn't even start up, as soon as I open it it crashes with no warning or error at all.

Does anyone know of a mix extractor which is not retarded? IE will actually allow me to extract the files I wish? Note it doesn't have to play VQAs, view W3Ds etc I have other programs/plugins etc for that.

For RenegadeEx it works really well. For the xcc tool it freezes when it startups because you
need to give it time. When it start just let it sit there so it can find all of you Westwood/EA games.

Then it will not freeze. The next time you use it it will load a lot faster.
