Restarted. File isn't there. Even in DOS prompt the dir command doesn't show it. If i had a floppy drive i would re-boot in DOS and try.

I Even tried deleting it in dos with a wildcard (\*.exe) but it said it wasn't there.

Ran nod32 (anti virus) nothing comes up.
