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At this time I am officially announcing that I will no longer be actively developing BReNBot for various reasons. This means BR 2.0 is cancelled as of this post, and will not be developed further. Lately I have been working on other projects, and simply do not have the desire to continue working on BReNBot anymore.

While I will no longer be actively developing BReNBot I will still provided limited support for existing versions, and will patch any major bugs in 1.52, although to the best of my knowledge it is a fairly stable version as far as BReNBot goes.

I will not be leaving the Renegade community at this time, although I may be less active around the community forums than I have been previously. The IPDB server will continue to be hosted by Tsolutions and maintained by myself.

I know this will be quite a disappointment to many of you, but this is something I have to do. If you have any further questions feel free to ask.
