If BRenBot has problems or bugs you should report them. To date I am aware of about 3 bugs with the 1.52 version, all of which are extremely minor and do not affect it's main functionality.

As for this problem, this is a PAR problem, not a BRenBot problem. PAR is the packer used to combine all the BRenBot code files into an exe file, and it sometimes goes a bit wonky, and this problem usually happens when the PAR cache becomes corrupt.

Delete the folder 'par-<your windows username>' in the following location;

XP: C:\Documents and Settings\<your_windows_username>\Local Settings\Temp Vista: C:\Users\<your_windows_username>\AppData\Local\temp\

(NB: For both of these the folder is hidden, and you will need to either type the address into the address bar or set Windows Explorer to show hidden folders.
