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First, driving reverse with a tank helps dodge/retreat faster as far as i know. "Toggle the attach camera to turret" in the menu.

I don't know about sniping, not very good at it, all i know is that you should keep moving, also move in a more random way, so it's harder to hit you. Most people jump all the time, it helps sometimes.

Very important thing tho is to use 3rd person and some people prefer to use V (free camera) too

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Many tanks have their turret positioned more near the rear of the vehicle (Artillery, Light Tank, maybe the Medium, etc.). Say you were going around the corner on Field with an Artillery, you'd want to expose as little of your vehicle as possible, so with the turret on the rear, you only expose as much rather than almost the whole thing.

Some vehicles, like the Mammoth Tank, etc. have no real advantage to driving backwards, as they're so large and/or have turrets near the front or middle.

As for sniping, practice makes perfect. A lot of those snipers are people who've played the game recently and a lot, I imagine.
