looks like you zoomed in too much. You could zoom out a bit then use the tool in the right bottom of the screen that looks like a < to zoom in without making the model disappear. Press the cube in a frame on the right bottom to make the camera show your object.

Also, when I hold my mouse on the perspective view,

it gives me this coordination on the bottem:

X: [-1,#QO] Y: [-1,#QO] Z: [-1,#QO]

On the other screens when I hold my mouse on it,

it gives the right coordinations, for example:

X: [0,0] Y: [-1] Z: [0,2]
