Unless you have a 56K modem, set it to LAN/T1. This (probably) changes your default bandwith budget (You can do it directly from the command-console thing, press F8, type sbbo ######## in KBPS) to a nice large number, which means the server will send you more updates. There used to be (still is, but BRenBot counters it) an exploit whereby you'd set your bandwith to a low number, to give you advantageous lag.
