I do know about the shimmer when rubbing aginst something, and I was not aginst a wall, or close enough to be seen, just pressing forward w/o shift, so I was running, not walking, and was a GDI barriks and a half away from the enemy that shot at me. So I assume from what I read from above that the running made the glow skin work. They said if your walking slowly you would be totally invisable, and I was running. I also know walinkg through Tibirium causes the shimmer, hit by weapons fire or blast radius from explosive causes shimmer, and if you are close enough to a stealth unit, you can see the shimmer (faintly).
