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BEFORE installing scripts 4.0 / TT i created a clear, pure 1.037 renegade installation out of TheFirstDecade, german language.

While installing 4.0 it downloaded 500 MB always.dat, because "This Version is not 1.037".

I wondered why it was necessary to download 1.037, if it was already installed.....?

I dont want to download every installtion 500 MB, takes a while.

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It's indeed caused by the different language. TFD sets the language value incorrectly, which is why the installer thinks the files are corrupted and downloads them again.

I'm not sure why it said that you did not have 1.037 installed though. As far as I know that is set correctly by TFD, but maybe not.
