I'm making this post for my buddy since he is not able to get online today. Basically he can't run the Scripts 4.0 exe file on his new Windows 8 machine. He says that when you double click the file a compatibility error prompts him on the screen. He also said that he tried switching the compatibility to windows 98 / me (right clicking -> properties -> compatibility) & it still didn't allow him to open the file.. Also, when attempting to run as administrator, he was prompted with a message that said "error the file name was bad" or "file couldn't be found" (something of that order I can't remember exactly what the error said).

With the above said, does anyone have any idea how to fix a problem like this? Is this problem common on windows 8? Sorry the post is so vague but I really want my buddy to play C&C Ren with me and this is the only problem we're dealing with!
