Get them from <http://www.radgametools.com> and download the tools set. The files have a *.bik extension and should be located on the CD.

For other C&C games you will need XCC mixer to extract the VQA files and then a player such as XCC AV player. It's pretty straightfoward and you don't need to install the game to extract or view them.
