b) Not being able to upload because you can't remember a password is not a legitimate reason to boycott a service lol. Try clicking the "forgot your password" link. All you have to do is enter your EMAIL ADDRESS (you can remember THAT right?) and it emails you a new password

c) I'm sure you do, and I think its cool that you made it. I'm simply pointing out that it is redundant and there is a much more stable FREE service that you and everyone can and are allready using.

I could spend the day and write an HTTP server in PERL, but wouldn't it be silly for me to then suggest other people should use it instead of Apache/IIS etc?
